PUBLICATION POLICY

The GLC-SPIL International Law Journal (ILJ) is dedicated to maintaining the highest standards of academic and research integrity. Authors are strongly encouraged to consult the [Committee on Publication Ethics' International Standards for Authors](#).

We strive to adhere to the following publication policies. Kindly note that submissions that fail to conform to these guidelines may be returned or rejected.

1. ACCEPTANCE

All submissions to GLC-SPIL ILJ undergo initial scrutiny by the Editorial Board to evaluate their suitability for inclusion in the Journal. If deemed appropriate, submissions will proceed to a double-blind peer review process, with the final selection based on the peer review outcomes.

Upon completion of the review, the corresponding author will be notified of the result. Authors should be prepared to implement any changes requested by the Editorial Board prior to publication.

Proofs will be sent to the corresponding author via email, and any necessary corrections should be made promptly.

2. PUBLICATION

If a submission submitted to GLC-SPIL ILJ has also been submitted to and accepted by any other journal or online platform, the author must withdraw it from those platforms. If GLC-SPIL ILJ accepts the contribution first, the author (s) is required to withdraw it from all other journals and platforms. Failure to comply will result in the removal of the piece from

consideration for publication in GLC-SPIL ILJ. All final submissions, once completed and approved, will be published in the GLC-SPIL ILJ.

3. COPYRIGHT

Submitted work must be original, unpublished, and not under review elsewhere. If previously published figures, tables, or text are included, authors must secure permission from the copyright holder before submission.

As a condition of publication, authors must grant an exclusive licence to GLC-SPIL ILJ. This allows for consistent and efficient management of third-party reproduction requests and enables broader dissemination of the article. By assigning copyright to GLC-SPIL ILJ, authors retain the right to use their material in other works, provided they acknowledge the journal as the original place of publication and notify GLC-SPIL ILJ in writing beforehand.

Author (s) agrees to indemnify GLC-SPIL ILJ, against any claims related to copyright infringement, plagiarism, or unauthorised use. Proven instances of copyright infringement or plagiarism will lead to automatic disqualification. GLC-SPIL ILJ retains the right to retract any published work if such issues are discovered post-publication.

The manuscript will be considered the property of GLC-SPIL ILJ which reserves the right to publish it as deemed appropriate.

4. MISCELLANEOUS

Please be advised that submissions failing to meet these guidelines may be returned or rejected. While we aim to offer substantive feedback for each submission, the volume of submissions may sometimes prevent us from doing so. GLC-SPIL ILJ reserves the right to reject submissions without detailed feedback.

For any cases not covered by this policy, the decision of GLC-SPIL ILJ will be final and binding.
